He/she prepares or receives, from the Tax Systems Analyst, detailed workflow charts and diagrams to illustrate sequence of steps that the program must follow and describes input and logical operations involved. The incumbent analyses workflow charts and diagrams, applying knowledge of computer capabilities, subject matter, and symbolic logic. He/she writes instructions to guide operating personnel during production runs and analyses reviews and rewrites programs to increase operating efficiency or upgrades programs to new requirements.
